



count to 100 by Is and 10s, count forward starting at any number, write numbers and show their representation, understand greater/less than as well as comparisons, decompose numbers by tens and ones, sort objects, positional words, name 2d and 3d shapes, add and subtract problems up to 10, show sums in different ways, and add/subtract fluently to 5.


